Spectator Information

Scrutineering - Elgin High Street (Friday 22nd April) From 15:00 to 21:00
 See the cars up close as they are checked for their safety standards in the centre of Elgin before they compete on the stages the following day. The cars will start to arrive on the Plainstones, on Elgin High Street, from 15:00 on Friday 22nd April.

SS1 & 2 - McDonald & Munro Cooper Park First car due 09:00
 The viewing areas in the Park can be accessed from Elgin's Lossie Green car park (see below). Turn to your right as you enter the park and walk past Elgin Library. From here you can watch the cars tackle a hairpin left around Grant Lodge and then a 90 degree left around the Bowling Club. Do not try and access any other area of the stage as these are strictly non-spectator.

Service - Keith Showground First car due 11:35 and 14:15
 The crews will visit the Showground in Keith twice during the day for a service - with the first car due at 11:35 for their first service and then back again at 14:15 for their second service of the day.

SS6 - Gartly Moor First car due 12:45
 The spectator car park for this stage is accessed from the public road off the A96 at the top of the crawler lane after the Glens of Foundland (to the east of Huntly). After approx two miles turn right into the forest and follow the arrows to the car park adjacent to the stage.

Re-Group - Huntly Square First car due 13:05
 Come see the cars and crews up-close in the heart of Huntly as they assemble in the town's Square from 13:05 between stages. Each car should be in the regroup for 20 minutes with the last car expected to leave at approximately 15:00.

SS9 - Ordiequish First car due 15:35
 The spectator car park for this stage is accessed from the public road off the A96 to the east of Fochabers. After approx one mile follow the arrows and turn right off the public road and into the forest and car park.

Finch - Moray College UHI First car due 16:24
 At the end of the day, cars and crews will arrive back at Moray College UHI - entering from the Moray Street entrance - where the winner will be announced and the top three competitors will spray champagne to celebrate.
